

7 Blessings

1. The Lord will set you high above all the nations of the earth! Deut. 28:1.

We, the church, are a holy nation, raised up with Christ and seated in heavenly places, high above all rule and authority, power and dominion. Jesus has transferred all of his power and authority to the church and put the church over all things. We are to rule and reign on the earth and take the place of Jesus until he comes.

2. The Lord will cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before you! Deut. 28:7.

5. The Lord will make you abound in prosperity! Deut. 28:11.

Let them continually say: Great is the Lord, who delights in the prosperity of his servant, Psalm 35:27. Say this to yourself often. 6. The Lord will open to you his good treasure, the heavens, to give rain to your land and to bless all the work of your hands. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow! Deut. 28:6.

God has opened to you his treasure room in heaven, his vault. All of his riches in glory are yours in Christ Jesus. He will meet all your needs and all your desires, according to his riches in glory. God spoke these words to Reinhard Bonnke: "Don't count on what is in your pocket, but count on what is in my pocket." God's pockets are always full, overflowing. "I will open the windows of heaven for you and pour out for you a blessing until there is no more need. All nations will call you blessed, for you will be a land of delight," Malachi 3:10-12. This is God's promise to those who honor him with their tithes and offerings. Give and it will be given unto you, Luke 6:38.

7. The Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you shall only go up and not down! Deut. 28:13.
