


## Blessed in all things

*“Beloved, I pray that you may prosper **in all things** and be in health even as your soul prospers.* (3 John 2). God wants it to go well with us spiritually, physically and materially. Jesus was obedient in my place and fulfilled all of God’s conditions so that I can be blessed. Through faith in the finished work of Jesus, we receive the blessing of Abraham today – for free.

*“As his divine power has given us **all things** that pertain to life and godliness ...”* 2 Peter 1:3. Everything we need for life here on earth God has already given us, in Christ.
